### Section 3 - Hazard Identification

White to slightly yellow flake or pastille; mild fatty odor.

#### Potential Health Effects

**Skin Contact:** Repeated or prolonged skin contact may cause mild skin irritation.

**Unusual Fire and Explosion Hazards:** Melts to form a clear liquid at about 100°F. Will melt and burn, but will not ignite readily. Avoid use of solid stream of water as burning material will float.
