Section 3 - Hazard Identification

Appearance/Odor: Clear to slight yellow liquid; mild characteristic odor

Potential Health Effects

Skin Contact: May irritate skin on repeated or prolonged exposure.

Eye Contact: May irritate eyes.

Ingestion: May irritate gastrointestinal tract if swallowed. May cause nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

Inhalation: Vapors from hot product may cause dizziness.

Section 4 - First Aid Measures

Skin Contact: Wash affected skin with soap and water. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

Eye Contact: Flush eyes with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

Ingestion: Induce vomiting if conscious, as directed by a physician.

Inhalation: Person should be moved to a fresh air environment. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Seek medical attention.

Section 5 - Explosion and Fire-Fighting Measures

Extinguishing Media: CO₂, Dry Chemical, Foam, Water Fog

Special Fire-Fighting Procedures: A MSHA/NIOSH approved self-contained breathing apparatus should be worn.

Unusual Fire and Explosion Hazards: None. Thermal decomposition may produce irritating or toxic gases, fumes, smoke or particulates.

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Section 6 - Accidental Release/Spill Procedures

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: Wear suitable protective equipment. Eliminate any ignition sources. Dike and contain the spill with inert material (i.e., sand, earth, sawdust) and transfer liquid and solid diking material to separate containers for recovery or disposal. Wash floor area with hot water solution. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash affected skin areas with soap and water. Keep spills out of all sewers and bodies of water.

Section 7 - Handling and Storage

Any use of this product in an elevated temperature process should be evaluated to establish and maintain safe operating procedures.

Keep from contact with oxidizing materials.

Containers should be kept tightly closed and stored in a dry well-ventilated place
